The wine combines juicy fruit flavors and spices, with a rich and powerful body. It is a restrained and elegant wine with a Mediterranean character, that will continue to develop over the years.

About Harvest 2019

A winter saturated with precipitation caused the soil to saturated with water ahead of the growing season. The quantity of available water caused strong green growth initially and a shortening of the growing stages. The months of June, July and August were simply comfortable with hot temperatures during the day but pleasant nights throughout most of the country, which brought an ideal change of color, slow and good ripening and an accumulation of wonderful flavors in the grains of the grapes.

About the Growing Area

A layered vineyard planted on the peaks of the Judean Hills, 900 meters above sea level. The Marselan grapes grew on Terra Rossa soil on the cool peaks of the Judean Hills, which allows the fleshy variety to maintain the freshness of the fruit and the delicate aromatics.
